Year of Mercy Comes to a Close

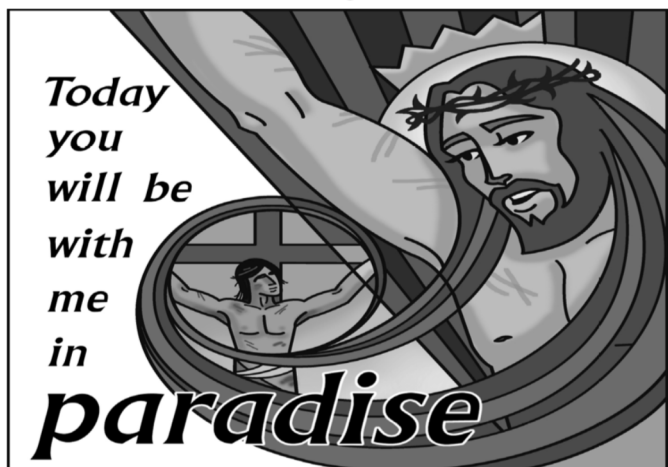

The Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy concludes on Sunday, November 20, the Solemnity of Christ the King, with the closing of the Holy Door in the Basilica of St. Peter, Rome. This Mass will be available for viewing via livestream at youtube.com/vatican at 1:00 am Pacific time (live) or on EWTN television at 1:00 am (live), with EWTN rebroadcast at 9:00 and 11:00 am, and 9:00 pm.

On the preceding Sunday, November 13, the Holy Doors in dioceses globally were closed, including those in our archdiocese. Optional special prayers and suggestions for celebrating the conclusion of the Extraordinary Jubilee were sent to pastors from Laura Bertone, Director of the Office of Worship.
