**First Reading** — Filled with the Holy Spirit, the apostles begin to speak in tongues (Acts 2:1-11).

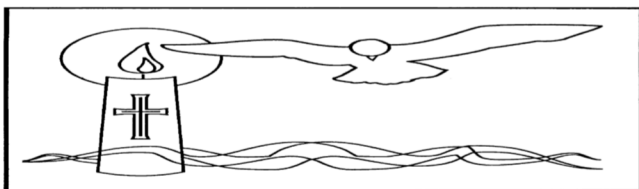
**Psalm** — Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth (Psalm 104).

May is Mental Health Awareness Month, and the California Catholic Conference of Bishops (CCC) have taken the opportunity to bring a voice and awareness to the mental health struggles and challenges facing so many. On May 2, the CCC released "Hope and Healing: A Pastoral Letter from the Bishops of California on Caring for Those Who Suffer from Mental Illness Addressed to All Catholics and People of Goodwill," addressing the question of mental health and the critical need to attend to those who suffer.
